



LRFC.POL.007 MINIROO PLAYER REQUESTING TO PLAY UP FROM NOMINATED AGE GROUP

1. Purpose

To support the philosophy of continuing to challenge its Miniroo players whilst ensuring compliance with the Club's Duty of Care and the Fair Play Policy.

2. Requirements

For a Miniroo player to be eligible to play up from his/her nominated Age Group no more than 1 year, the Parents/Guardians must have read this Policy, they must register the individual online at My Football Club as a player, they have completed the Section 1 of LRFC.FRM.007 and provided this to the LRFC Committee, the player has completed designated assessments as shown in Section 2 of LRFC.FRM.007, be authorised by the current LRFC Committee and Coaching Coordinator as shown in Section 3 of LRFC.FRM.007, and there is a Playing Roster Space.

3. Definitions

Playing Roster Space - A younger player wanting to play in an older age group, no more than 1 year above his/her Nominated Age Group, can only be consider to play up if there is an open spot in the older age group. Preference will be given to players of the correct age first over younger ones, as playing down is not an option for these players.

Miniroo - The player must be between the ages of 5 and 12 years of age.

4. Procedure

Applications to be a member/player of the LRFC must be made online at My Football Club and accepted by the Registrar of the LRFC.

All Registration fees must be paid for his/her Nominated Age group.

Complete & Mail or Scan & Email the Completed Section 1 of LRFC.FRM.007 Miniroo Player Request to Play above Nominated Age Group Form.

Complete the following designated Assessments to undertaken by the Coaching Coordinator and relevant Coach/s:

1. Technical Ability - A player must demonstrate a high degree of individual skill which must be transferable to competitive match situations. In addition, a player's individual skill must meet or excel the technical abilities of other participating players within the age group the player wishes to participate in.
2. Physical Ability - A player must surpass other players within their age group in physical strength, technical skill and speed, and have the ability to blend in with players of the intended age group.
3. Mental Ability - Player must surpass other players within their age group in game awareness and general knowledge of the game. To include the mental strength that will be necessary when dealing with older and physically superior opponents.
4. Social Ability - Player must be able to interact with players within the intended age group on and off the field (games, dressing room, training and social gatherings).
